- Students selected at their home universities for an academic exchange stay at UAB must fill in an online Application Form at the site http://sia.uab.es, after the nomination of their home university.
- Incoming students must send the following documents:
- learning agreement signed by home university
- transcript of records
- language certificate

in order to receive (by e-mail) a letter of admission and a letter containing useful information on their academic exchange stay at the UAB. Without these documents the student will not be admitted.

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks. After having received the paper application (printed online application) the letter of admission will be send within a max. period of six weeks.
