

Prof. Alina Elena Pârvu, MD, PhD

(Cluj-Napoca, Romania)

Born 1958 in Cluj-Napoca, Romania, Dr. Alina Elena Pârvu studied Medicine at "Iuliu Hatieganu" University of Medicine and Pharmacy from Cluj-Napoca (MD in 1984). Between 1984 and 1994 she worked as a family doctor in Arad and Cluj-Napoca, Romania. From 1994 to 1998 she was a PhD student in the Department of Physiology at the "Iuliu Hatieganu" University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Cluj-Napoca (PhD in 1998). Then she worked in the Department of Pathophysiology of the same university, and in 2015 she was appointed professor of Pathophysiology, a position which she holds up to now.

Key areas of research interest are inflammation and oxidative stress. These are addressed in disease-orientated studies for diagnostic, prognostic, preventive or therapeutic purposes, when testing the effect of drugs, plant extracts or new synthesized compounds.

Dr. Alina Elena Pârvu published more than 150 articles in journal as Molecules, Frontiers in Pharmacology, Plos One, Acta Pharmaceutica Sinica, Phytotherapy Research, Antioxidants, Scietific Reports, and her h-index is 19. Research funding was provided by 11 research grants (1 international and 10 national).

Dr. Alina Elena Pârvu was involved in teaching the Pathophysiology module of the Joint Program for European Medical Studies (JPEMS) (2011-2018) in Nantes and Angers, France, and in Cluj-Napoca, Romania.
