

PROVISIONS REGARDING THE PROCEDURE OF CONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE

According the Order of the Romanian Ministry of Education No. 3693/2024 for the approval of the Frame-methodology regulating the admission to short-term, bachelor, master and doctoral higher education studies approved by the Board Decision No 11/10905/14.05.2024, Art. 25

According to Art. 6, paragraph 6 of the Order No. 3693/2024, published in the Official Monitor of Romania, High-school graduates from internationally accredited systems recognised by the Romanian Ministry of Education have the right to participate in the admission process, including in the year when graduated high-school, and to be **provisionally** the admitted candidate having to submit the actual international accepted, baccalaureate/equivalent diploma no later than 6 months from graduation. If the admitted candidate does not submit the international baccalaureate/equivalent diploma within the established deadline, they will be expelled. This provision refers to any of the situations below, already stipulated in the Regulation on the organisation and conduct of the admission competition undergraduate programmes and undergraduate programmes offered jointly within the University of Medicine and Pharmacy "Victor Babeş" in Timisoara:

1. Graduates of the current year who haven't received the final diploma of international baccalaureate can apply for the admission competition organized by our university (type I, II, III or admission to the Romanian language preparatory programme for foreign citizens) with the following documents: - Summary results/statement of results issued by the International Baccalaureate Organization = Graduation certificate, official document (valid only for graduates who have not received the final diploma of the baccalaureate/equivalent exam) which contains and explicitly reflects the passing of the baccalaureate/equivalent exam and the final results obtained by the candidate in this exam/The certificate issued by the educational institution, in place of the baccalaureate diploma, if it has not been issued - for candidates who have passed the baccalaureate examination in the session corresponding to the current school year – according Prorectorat Relații Internaționale

to the section Documents needed to enrol for the admission competition from chapters III.3, IV.4, V.4, of the Regulation on the organisation and conduct of the admission competition undergraduate programmes and undergraduate programmes offered jointly within the University of Medicine and Pharmacy "Victor Babeş" in Timisoara, respectively chapter IV from the Methodology for the organisation and conduct of the admission examination to the Romanian Language Preparatory Programme for Foreign Citizens at the University of Medicine and Pharmacy "Victor Babes" of Timisoara.

2. In case of study documents that were issued by schools functioning according to the British system, we do not accept *predictive = hypothetical* results (candidates who haven't yet passed the baccalaureate/equivalent exam). The university accepts only study documents reflecting the final and definitive grades obtained at the baccalaureate/equivalent exam. The GCE (General Certificate of Education) is obligatory; the GCE can be replaced by the Statement of Results, a document which explicitly reflects the fact that the candidate has successfully passed the baccalaureate/equivalent exam and contains the final results obtained by the candidate at this exam.

This provision has been set according to the provisions of the Centre for the Recognition and Validation of Diplomas of the Romanian Ministry of Education and Research, that does not accept predicted grades either.

3. Highschool graduates of the current year, regardless of the admission competition they are applying for, have the obligation to submit the graduation certificate, official document (valid only for graduates who have not received the final diploma of the baccalaureate/equivalent exam) which contains and explicitly reflects the passing of the baccalaureate/equivalent exam and the final results obtained by the candidate in this exam/The certificate issued by the educational institution, in place of the baccalaureate diploma, if it has not been issued - for candidates who have passed the baccalaureate examination in the session corresponding to the current school year. By way of exception, in the case of the University's interconnection with the Integrated Information System for Education in Romania (SIIIR) in order to retrieve the personal data and baccalaureate results of these candidates, on the basis of their written agreement, the attestation issued by the educational institution is not required.

4. The mechanism and admission procedure for candidates who apply for the Type III International admission competition, respectively for the admission competition for the Romanian language preparatory program for foreign citizens, is carried out according to the provisions of the Regulation on the organisation and conduct of the admission competition undergraduate programmes and undergraduate programmes offered jointly within the University of Medicine and Pharmacy "Victor Babes" in Timisoara, respectively of the Methodology for the organisation and conduct of the admission examination to the Romanian Language Preparatory Programme for Foreign Citizens at the University of Medicine and Pharmacy "Victor Babes" of Timisoara, the baccalaureate/equivalent average being taken into account in the admission competition for all categories of candidates, thus constituting a decisive criterion in the admission process of candidates.

5. Additionally, conditional acceptance is regulated within the admission methodologies of the International Type III admission competition, in the case of citizens of RO, EU, EEA, CH, British citizens and their family members and citizens of third countries, also by requiring admitted candidates to submit a notarial declaration - only for the candidates who submit the graduation certificate (the official document valid only for graduates who have not received the final diploma of the baccalaureate/equivalent exam) which contains and explicitly reflects the passing of the baccalaureate/equivalent exam and the final results obtained by the candidate in this exam – by which they undertake to submit to the university their baccalaureate/equivalent diploma in original, legalized/super-legalized copy and authorized translation into Romanian immediately after obtaining it from the issuing high school. The deadline depends on the issuing country.

Considering the fact that all candidates for undergraduate university studies take the university admission competition under the same conditions, depending on the category and type of admission (I, II, III or admission to the Romanian Language Preparatory Programme for Foreign Citizens), introducing specific provisions that differentiate certain candidates by exempting them from certain mandatory provisions, means breaking the rules imposed by the Ministry of education and Research, leading to discriminatory and non-inclusive approach.

According to Article 10, paragraph 2 of the Order 3693/2024, the participation of a candidate in the admission competition is conditional on having passed the baccalaureate/equivalent exam, even if the candidate hasn't yet obtained the final diploma, and the predicted grades do not reflect this and cannot be accepted as final results.
